All paper submissions must represent original work, cannot have been previously published, and must be written in ENGLISH

Proposals must be submitted as a Microsoft WORD or RTF attachment (you can use example file!)

The abstract must include: SESSION, PAPER TITLE, AUTHOR'S NAME, EMAIL ADDRESS

Number of WORDS < 400 (only the text)

You must attach a CV (words <100) to your proposal submission (see example file)

Proposals may be for a twenty-minute paper, or for a ten-minute presentation

Details for Full Paper

Accepted papers must be submitted in full by **2009 September, 6.**

Language: ENGLISH

Paper must be submitted as a Microsoft WORD or RTF attachment

Paper must include PAPER TITLE, AUTHOR'S NAME, AFFILIATION

Number of WORDS < 2000

The contributes will be for a twenty-minute paper. A Power-point or pdf support presentation is encouraged.

All contributors must be registered before 2009 August, 7
